## Addition War

Materials: Deck of cards (with face cards
removed)

## Instructions:

-Choose one number to add, before starting the game ( $+4,+5$, $+6,+7,+8$, or +9 ). Play with this number the whole game.
-Play like regular War, except that when you each flip a card, you both have to add $\qquad$ to the value of the card you flipped and say the sum out loud.

Example: If we are playing +8 Addition War and I flip a 6, I have to say "6 + 8 =14".
-Player with the largest sum wins all the cards.
-If there is a tie, each player puts 3 cards face down and flips again to see who has the largest sum. Winner of the war gets all of the cards.
-Play until time is up, or one player has no more cards.
***Important: You must say the equation and sum aloud each time, even if you already know who has the largest sum. That's how we are practicing our addition skills!
***If you're ready to practice your MULTIPLICATION skills, you can play this game the same way, but instead pick a number to multiply by!
