## Skunk

## Materials:



- 2 Dice
- One gameboard per player- create on scrap paper as pictured here



## Instructions:

1. Each letter in the word "skunk" represents a round in the game. Play begins in the " S " column and continues through the " $K$ " column.
2. The object of the game is to have the most points accumulated by the end of the 5 rounds. At the end, you will add the points in all 5 columns together to determine the winner.
3. For each round:

- Roll the 2 dice.
- The players add the 2 numbers together and write that total in the column on their own gameboard. Each player decides if they want to stop and keep those points safe or take a chance and keep rolling for more points.


## Careful!!

* If a $\mathbf{1}$ is rolled, play is over for that round and all of the players who are still rolling for points get a zero for that round!
** If double 1's are rolled and you are still "in" for that round, ALL of the points that you've accumulated in ALL rounds so far are lost!!
- If no 1's are rolled, players may choose either to keep trying for more points on the next roll or to stop and keep what has been accumulated in that round.

Note: If a 1 or a double 1's are rolled in the very first roll of a round, then that round is over and no players get points that round.
